for the offline bidding procedure with minimum price

Auction at Crystal Challenge Arabian Horses Switzerland (CCAHS)

All items offered are purchased as described or viewed.

The contracting parties agree that ownership of the item passes to the buyer upon full payment of the purchase price. The seller declares that at the time of full payment there are no third party rights to the item and that, with reference to Article 234 Paragraph 3 of the Swiss Code of Obligations (OR), as far as is legally permissible, any warranty and liability is excluded.

Submitting and sending a bid to the seller is a binding declaration of intent to purchase an item. Bids that have already been submitted can always be improved prior to the expiry of the time limit. Prospective buyers submit their bids in writing and in person, either by post or email. Bids submitted by post will only be considered up to two days before the end of the auction. Date of receipt by the recipient applies. The participating bidders are only informed of the current highest bid by email on request.

At the end of the auction, the bidder with the highest bid is accepted and the purchase offer is deemed to have been accepted, provided that the minimum price has been reached or exceeded, whereupon an effective purchase contract is concluded with the highest bidder. The highest bidder is informed separately, including notification of possible payment and shipping methods.

The buyer has 10 days to pay the purchase price. After receipt of payment, the item is handed over or delivered to the buyer immediately.

The item can be collected or sent by courier / post. Shipping costs are borne by the buyer. The seller declines all liability from the moment the item is handed over to the courier, postal service or buyer.
